OBJECTIVE

To inform the new interline baggage rules to flights to /from Canada.

NUEVA DISPOSICION

The Canadian Transportation Agency (CTA) issued Decision No.144-A-2014 on April 15, 2014.

- The Decision provides new rules for air carriers when participating in an interline itinerary issued on a single ticket whose origin or ultimate destination is a point in Canada.
- The CTA decide to align Canada's interline baggage rules with those of the United States Department of Transportation ("DOT").
- The new rules apply to itineraries involving multiple air carriers to or from Canada, purchased on a single ticket.
- The new Interline Baggage Rules for Canada become effective on **April 1, 2015 for tickets issued on or after April 1, 2015**
- The Agency's decision now requires the carriers:
 1. Apply a single set of baggage rules for interline traffic transportation to/from Canada and
 2. Disclose to passenger, on the passenger's e-ticket or on any summary page of a carrier's web site at the end of an online purchase, the applicable interline baggage rules.
